NEWS FROM THE WATERVILLE HISTORICAL SOCIETY



LOST & FOUND PROGRAM

The Waterville Historical Society is hosting a program titled "Lost and Found? Noted Toledo Architect George B. Rheinfrank and Waterville, Ohio" on Wednesday, May 15, 7:00 pm at Wakeman Hall, 401 Farnsworth Rd., Waterville. Edward Hill, Special Collections Librarian and Curator of the Blade Rare Book Room at Toledo-Lucas County Public Library will discuss architectural drawings which are part of a previously unknown collection discovered in 2017 and acquired by the Library. George B. Rheinfrank (1874-1960) designed many notable buildings in Toledo and the surrounding area, some of which still survive. Join us to learn about Rheinfrank's connection to Waterville and about this recently discovered collection.

This program is free and open to the public.

WALKING TOUR

The Waterville Historical Society is again hosting a Historic Homes of Waterville Tour on Saturday, June 15, 2019. The tour will run from 10:00 am to 4:00 pm, rain or shine, and features 7 historic homes, plus the Waterville United Methodist Church. One of the homes is a 1908 Sears Catalogue Home and has been kept in pristine condition with lots of stories to tell.

Tickets are \$20.00 per person and are available for sale at Waterville Hardware (30 N. Third St.), the Waterville Library (800 Michigan Ave.), and on Wednesdays from 10:00-2:00 at Wakeman Hall, 401 Farnsworth Rd. They can also be purchased online at www.watervillehistory.org (under Events), or at each stop on the day of the tour.

Two free shuttle busses will be available during the day, with parking located at J&R Contracting, 1300 Michigan Ave. The Waterville United Methodist Church (102 N. Fifth St.) will also be serving a lunch that day from 11:00-1:00, for donation only, and as they are a stop on the tour, a perfect place to rest and rejuvenate!

In addition, the AW Area Arts Commission is hosting their Art and About 2019 event that day, featuring local artists painting outside around town, and a scavenger hunt in the downtown area. For more information, visit www.awaac.org.

The tour is a fund-raising event to support the education, renovations, and preservation work of the Waterville Historical Society. Join us for a story-filled day and step back in time through these lovely buildings that reflect a Waterville of long ago.



Waterville Area Chamber of Commerce Business Development Grant

The Waterville Area Chamber of Commerce has established a grant funding program to encourage private business in the Waterville Area to expand, maintain, or rehabilitate existing commercial and industrial enterprises as well as to provide additional startup funds for new business. Total grant monies to be awarded on an annual basis will be at least \$1000 with a maximum of \$2000 to be determined by the financial standing of the Chamber.

What is it for?

- Renovations of existing buildings
- Fixed asset acquisition
- ♦ Inventory
- ♦ Training
- Maintenance of equipment
- Building repairs
- ♦ Startup Costs
- Other projects deemed appropriate as determined by the Grant Committee

Who Can Apply?

Any chamber member business in good standing.

How much can I receive?

- ♦ Up to \$1000.00
- Recipients can only receive funds once every three years

Must the monies be repaid?

 No - Provided funds are used for established purpose within 90 days of date awarded (unless otherwise agreed in advance)

When is the deadline for Applications?

◆ 2019 Applications are due June 28, 2019 by 12:00 p.m.

When will the grants be awarded?

 Recipients will be announced at the August Networking Luncheon (more information to follow) it is highly encouraged to attend.

What are the criteria for determining the recipients?

- The Grant Committee will consider the following criteria:
 - Membership in Chamber and length of time as a member
 - ◆ Creation of job(s) or job retention
 - ♦ Financial need
 - ♦ Likelihood of business continuation
 - ♦ Benefit to community
 - Percent of funding with other available monies
 - Other criteria as may be determined by the Grant Committee
